#### ON THE BEACH

The 2022/2023 season was a busy year for the Lifesavers who patrolled at Maroochydore Beach:

- 41 Rescues,
- 77 First Aid Treatments,
- 2,222 Preventative Actions while looking out for 86,140 beachgoers

All our activities on the beach are carried out by volunteers, however paid lifeguards are employed by Surf Life Saving Queensland and the Sunshine Coast Regional Council to patrol during the week.

Established in 1992, our supporters club 'Maroochy Surf Club' has become an iconic destination for local supporters and visitors to the Sunshine Coast.

As one of Australia's most respected clubs, Maroochy Surf Club is home to a Surf Bar, Beach Break Café, Flags Bistro, gaming room, and top floor function room.

For the 2023/2024 year the Maroochy Surf Club registered a total of **18,025 Members**.

Approximately **19,000 visitors** are recorded visiting our venue on a monthly basis, that's **220,000 visitors a year** from the greater Sunshine Coast region, across Australia and around the world.

Every year our free **courtesy bus drives 55,000km** and transports over **15,600 patrons** travelling to and from the venue in the Maroochydore, Mooloolaba, North/East Buderim, Mt Creek, Alexandra Headland and Kuluin areas.

### **CARNIVALS**

Surf Sport events are a cornerstone of the Surf Life Saving movement. Each summer Queensland's top lifesavers line up across the state to take on the surf and sand. Young and old, professionals and beginners alike come together at beaches across the State.

Maroochydore Surf Life Saving Club hosts two major surf sport carnivals annually on Maroochydore Beach:

# MURPHY HOMES 'MAROOCHY CLASSIC' (JANUARY)

The Murphy Homes 'Maroochy Classic' Carnival has been running for 11 years with a great partnership between Maroochydore Surf Life Saving Club and Murphy Homes/Builders. Each year the event promises to be bigger and better with a prize pool of over \$35,000. It is the biggest carnival run by the club and has the largest prize money for a single event that attracts some of the biggest athlete names in the sport.

### **CENTURY 21 SPORTS CARNIVAL** (NOVEMBER)

The Century 21 Sports Carnival has been hosted by Maroochydore Surf Life Saving Club for 6 years and attracts junior competitors from all over the State from U8 - U14s. Competing in a range of beach and water events, the Century 21 Sports Carnival is a fun event for junior competitors from all clubs to showcase their skills and abilities in a competitive environment and make new friends.



### **SURF SPORTS**

Maroochydore Surf Life Saving Club's continuing success in Surf Sports is due to a strong focus on development. We have implemented an athlete development program which allows surf sport athletes to further develop their skills and allows members to reach their full potential.

Maroochydore Surf Life Saving Club has produced some of the country's best surf sport athletes. The Club is committed to continuing this tradition as well as offering athletes of any ability the opportunities, skills and training to perform at their best.

#### **ATHLETES**

The Club employees seven professional coaches who all work extremely hard in supporting, mentoring and training athletes. With this comes a strong support structure, a culture of success and development pathways to help young members achieve their goals.

#### **SURF CRAFT**

When competing individual craft is necessary for training purposes and used at Surf Sport events. This includes but is not limited to Nipper Boards, Paddle Boards, Rescue Boards and Surf Skis.

#### **OFFICIALS**

Maroochydore Surf Life Saving Club believes good officials make for well-run, well-supported surf carnivals, and our volunteer officials are required to become Level 1 Surf Sports Official accredited.



## **JUNIOR ACTIVITIES (NIPPERS)**

Junior Activities (also known as Nippers), is a fun way for young children and families to enjoy the beach in a safe environment. Maroochydore SLSC supports and offers the delivery of the SLSA Junior Development Program.

Nipper days are on Sundays at 7.50am – 10.30am from mid-September to approximately mid-March. The program is designed to ensure children have fun at the beach while participating in lessons that will provide them with a pathway in both lifesaving and surf sport activities.

#### **CELEBRATING 50 YEARS**

2018 was a very special year at Maroochydore SLSC as we celebrated 50 years of Nippers on Maroochydore Beach.

The idea of a 'Junior Club' came from and was formed by a Senior Member Ron Parton at a Saturday night members meeting in 1967. Before Nippers was even 'invented' Maroochydore 'Cygnets' started and today still stands as one of Queensland's original Nipper Clubs.

The Williamson brothers, Brett and Kirk, future Captain and Hon. Secretary respectively were Foundation Members of the 'Cygnets'. Brett then became CEO of both Surf Life Saving Queensland and Surf Lifesaving Australia. Both Brett and Kirk still volunteer for our Club, 50 years later.

This demonstrates how key Nippers is for engraining a love of lifesaving at a young age and arming our junior members with rescue techniques and skills that they take through to becoming a Lifesaver.
